SCSD emphasizes importance of Social Emotional Learning in newly developed ES report card

Starting next fall, the elementary report card will have a new look. One of the changes reflects the increased emphasis on social emotional learning. The District is committed to social emotional well-being as an integral part of academic success and the updated report card format and language reinforce that value.

"We changed the format to align with the social emotion learning benchmarks from New York State," said Spencerport Director of Curriculum Kristen Paolini. "We moved it to the top of the report card to demonstrate that a child's social emotional well-being is of the upmost importance to us."

In addition to updated placement and language specific to social emotional benchmarks, a new comment section has been added. It will allow teachers the space to address students' progress specific to social emotional learning benchmarks and separate from academic comments.
